## Cantamath 2008

1. Complete your **full school name** i.e. St Joseph's Papanui School
  2. **Two email addresses** that are currently valid are needed. Errors in email addresses supplied can prevent important information reaching schools and students.
  3. An **emergency contact** phone number (preferably a cell phone number) can be very helpful if arrangements suddenly change i.e. snow. Also we can quickly check when teams fail to turn up for the Preliminary Heats.
  4. A **second contact** will help to maintain continuity of communication from year to year as staff often change.
  5. Due to restricted floor space and safety requirements in the Town Hall Auditorium, it may be **necessary to run a Preliminary Heat** if there are too many entries at any level. The maximum number of teams is 80 at years 7 and 8.
  6. If a Preliminary Heat is necessary, only **complete entries** received by the closing date will be considered. Schools will be advised in Term 3 **via email**, if they have missed out on direct entry into the Finals and will need to compete in the Preliminary Heats. The Preliminary Heats start at 6.00 pm; there will be 10 questions in 15 minutes. The top 5 teams then qualify for the finals later that evening. Schools that have competed in the Preliminary Heats in the previous two years, progress directly into the Finals. The remaining schools are selected randomly to progress into the Finals.
  7. **At year 9 and 10 schools may enter 1 or 2 teams** at each year level. Schools that have a staff member on the Cantamath Committee or CMA Executive can enter up to 3 teams for years 9 and 10. Spaces are limited for the 3<sup>rd</sup> team and they will be allocated on a "first in first served" basis.
  8. **Lists of schools** and their teams entered will be on the website at the start of Term 3.
  9. In the month leading up to the competition, **Newsletters** will be emailed to schools. These will contain important information and reminders for competitors. If you have not received a Newsletter by the 5<sup>th</sup> of August please email [cantamath@gmail.com](mailto:cantamath@gmail.com).
  10. All **entry fees are non-refundable**. Please advise the Secretary immediately if a team or teams can not make the event by emailing [cantamath@gmail.com](mailto:cantamath@gmail.com).
  11. Entries received after the close off date will incur an **extra \$10 charge**. Entries will not be accepted until the \$10 late payment fee has been paid.
  12. Please make all cheques payable to the "**Canterbury Mathematical Association**" or "**CMA**".
