

Instructions to Spectators, Coaches and Teachers

Instructions to Spectators

A reminder to all that spectators must be seated upstairs in the auditorium. Only contestants plus one adult supervisor per team may be seated downstairs.

Years 7 and 8 only - Banner Competition

The banner is for supporting your school at the teams' competition on the appropriate night. It can only be used for one night and must be no larger than 5m x 2m. The banner can be hung over the balcony. There will be two prizes awarded this year. The first one will be for Best Visual Appeal which will be judged by the Cantamath committee and the other award will be for Best Crowd Choice which will be judged by applause from the audience.

Instructions to teachers and coaches

Teachers in charge of team(s) should complete the entry form sent to each school, and return it together with a cheque for \$40 for each team entered before the closing date.

Because of limited floor space and safety concerns, the organising committee cannot be responsible for allocating places to those schools whose entries are not with the Secretary by the closing date or those whose entries are not completed correctly. **Late and incomplete entries will not be considered.**

Year 7 and 8 teams may have to compete in a preliminary heat, please make sure you read all the relevant information.

Please ensure that you read the Instructions for Teams and Competition rules to your students before they begin the competition.

Year 9 and 10 teams, where schools have entered more than one team, we please ask the teams are numbers (i.e. Canterbury High School 1 and Canterbury High School 2 etc.) Please have teams sit in different rows from each other, this is so that they will not share a marker and risk their teams score being recorded incorrectly.

Collecting Display and Exhibition Entries

For some schools (Year 7 & 8) it is suggested they adopt a "buddy system" with their local High School to collect student work after 8pm on Thursday evening. Please provide schools with clear details of the student name, category, year level and brief description of the piece of work they are to collect on your behalf. Any work remaining will be disposed of by the Cantamath committee.

Question Sales

Those attending the team competitions are reminded that questions will be available for purchase at a cost of \$2 per year level at the end of each competition. Look for the sales desks or committee members who will have copies available.
